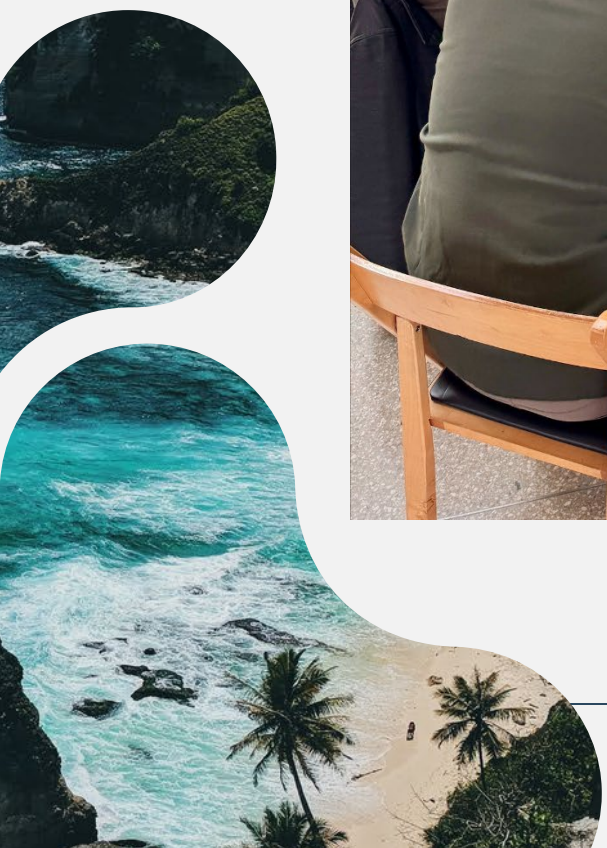
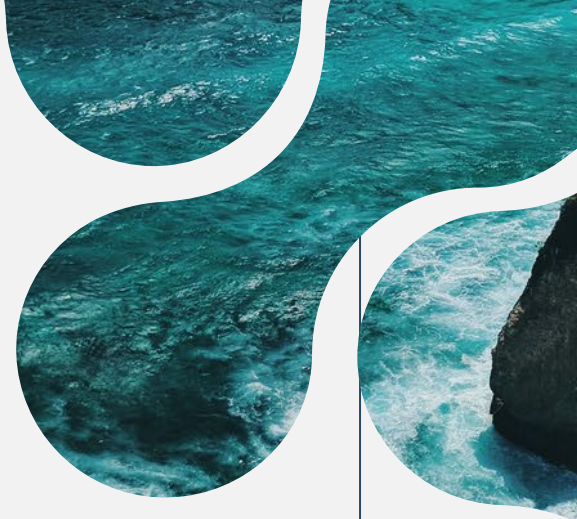

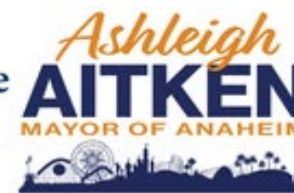

HOW DO I USE A COLLABORATIVE CONTRACT?

- **Step 1: Search for our collaborative contracts through Pavillion (visit their resource booth to learn more)**
- **Step 2: Contact the Contractor and reference the RCA and obtain a quote for your services.**
- **Step 3: Create a subordinate Contract.**
- **Step 4: Reporting to Pavillion to ensure you receive your piggybacking administrative rebates.**
